

JOSEPH DROUHIN, BROUILLY



DESCRIPTION

An elegant Beaujolais: intense ruby-red colour; on the nose, aromas of violet, lilac, sometimes blackberry and cranberry. Supple tannins, with lively acidity. On the palette, the wine leaves a pleasant note of wild berries.

VINIFICATION

Harvesting: by hand. Method: traditional for Beaujolais; semi-carbonic maceration, full clusters of grapes. Maceration: 4 to 10 days. Ageing: stainless steel vats.
