



DESCRIPTION

The nose is spicy, with notes of elderberries and wild blackberries. On the palate, Marselan reveals its fine structure and great complexity, with slight spicy notes and flavours of red berries, highlighted by a lasting freshness.

VINIFICATION

The Marselan grape variety was created in 1961 by crossing Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache noir. Domaine Tariquet was the first to introduce it in Gascony in 1999.
