

# JOSEPH DROUHIN, CHASSAGNE MONTRACHET BLANC



## DESCRIPTION

---

A generous and elegant wine. Light golden colour. Intense nose of flower, brioche and candied lime aromas, and as the wine matures evolving towards nuances of grilled hazelnut and spices. On the palette, the wine is straightforward, with a delicate texture and finesse. It has a long aftertaste where notes of flower and gingerbread dominate.

## VINIFICATION

---

Pressing: very slowly to respect the fruit. The juice from the last pressing is not used. No yeasts or enzymes are used. The wine goes directly into barrels after "débourage" (decanting of white wine to reduce sediment).
