DESCRIPTION

Fleurie is certainly worthy of its name! It possesses great charm and delicacy, with its bright raspberry colour, aromas of lilac, violet and gooseberry. Very supple and silky mouthfeel. Leaves a beautiful impression of fine aromas. It is the most delicate of the Beaujolais Crus.

VINIFICATION

Harvesting: by hand. Method: traditional for Beaujolais; semi-carbonic maceration, full clusters of grapes. Maceration: 4 to 10 days. Ageing: stainless steel vats.
