



DESCRIPTION

Powerful and very well-balanced with natural freshness, displaying a complex array of flavours elegantly combining notes of blackcurrant, blackberry and cedar with black pepper, enhanced by a touch of hazelnut and mocha. The powerful, refined finish goes on and on, suggesting excellent ageing potential.

VINIFICATION

The wine was aged in French oak barrels (55% new) for a total of 18 months.
