Non-Junmai: a sake where distilled alcohol, often from sugar cane, is added to the product. Honjozo: a grain size of 60-70%. Tokubetsu: This can be added to 'Honjozo' sakes and stands for; special/premium. This is one of the best variants of Honjozo that the brewery can produce. A delicate bouquet and light notes of lemon, lime and straw. After a lively first impression, you will notice this sake's refreshing, soft citrus flavours with a sweet, well-balanced finish.

UNIQUE SELLING POINTS

A lighter-bodied sake to which the sake master adds a small amount of alcohol prior to the filtering stage.
