

MARIMAR ESTATE, MAS CAVALLS PINOT NOIR



DESCRIPTION

Deep colour and intense fruit, remind of pomegrate and wild berries. The palette displays an array of flavors, from forest floor to coffee and mocha, spice and elegant oak. The mouthfeel is smooth, sensual and velvety.

VINIFICATION

The grapes are picked in the second and third week of September. The grapes are pressed shortly and gently, to not give off too much colour. The wine is fermented in stainless steel tanks and then undergoes a wood bearing in premium French oak kegs, of which 49% is new oak.
