DESCRIPTION

A wine with fresh aromas of green apple, fresh grass, and lemon. On the palate, the wine is bright and full with pure notes of tarragon, lemon, and green apple. Subtle hints of lime and fresh mint make the wine an experience. The finish is pure and crisp.

VINIFICATION

Fermentation takes place at low temperatures in order to preserve all of the grapes' aromas and flavours. The wine is then aged for a few months on fine lees.
