



DESCRIPTION

A very dark black-cherry colour with faint brick-red glints. It has an intense, complex nose with hints of black pepper, balsamic aromas and slight toastiness, reminiscent of fine oak. On the palate, the aging nuances are in perfect harmony with the fruit, with good tannin concentration, round and supple, with a long, silky smooth finish.

VINIFICATION

The grapes come from 80-years-old vines. barrel-aging begins in French-oak barrels and continues for 34 months, before bottling and aging for 3 years.
