

ORIN SWIFT, SLANDER



DESCRIPTION

This expressive California Pinot Noir is a masterpiece from Orin Swift, known for its bold style. The grapes are carefully selected and the wine ages for 9 months in French oak (30% new). In the glass, the wine displays a vibrant ruby red color. The nose opens with aromas of ripe black cherry, strawberry compote, wild raspberry, and a hint of white pepper and puff pastry. The palate is bright and lively, with notes of berry galette, a hint of blueberry and redcurrant. The tannins are soft and the finish is pleasant and refined.

VINIFICATION

Aging: 9 months in 30% new French oak for extra complexity.
