

MAPU, RESERVA CHARDONNAY



DESCRIPTION

Aspect: Bright and has a pale yellow color, with soft green highlights. Nose: High intensity, and presence of aromas of grapefruit, jasmine and peach. It also presents notes of gently roasted hazelnuts that come from its passage through wood. Palate: The attack is vibrant, has a tasty palate, it is round, with good volume. The end of the mouth is long, with notes of tropical fruits and soft notes of wood.

VINIFICATION

All the steps in the winemaking process for Mapu Reserva Chardonnay are designed to preserve freshness and extract all the fruit aromas and flavours.
