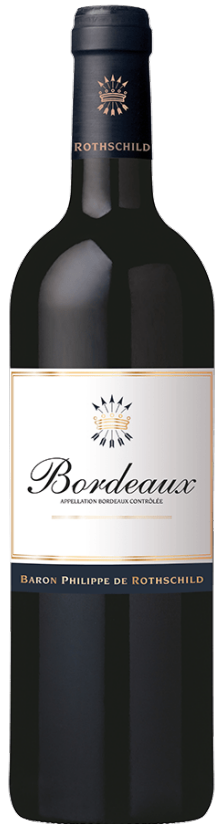


BORDEAUX AOC ROUGE



DESCRIPTION

An intense crimson red with a violet hue. The nose reveals fresh red fruit aromas before opening up on blackberry and bilberry notes. The round and crisp attack leads into a succulent mid-palate which reveals a lovely array of red and black fruit flavours, building to a finish on lingering black fruit notes.

VINIFICATION

The grapes are destemmed and lightly crushed. Alcoholic fermentation takes place in vats at controlled temperature in order to preserve all the expression of the fruit. The subsequent malolactic fermentation also takes place in the vat and helps to make the wines rounder and more supple.
